
Lecture 1 Notes: Introduction to Microbiology

Course Outline

- The coursework constitutes 50% of the grade and involves labster simulations, write ups, a poster, oral presentation, and Moodle quizzes (10%).
- Two practicals (20%): bacterial identification (10%) via 3 labster simulations and Gram stain method section (150 words) and a bacterial growth curve (10%) via 2 labster simulations and a results section.
- Team-work exercise in groups of 4. Involves reviewing a research paper together and creating a poster (10%). Then, there is an individual oral presentation of the whole poster (15%) via Panopto.

Introduction to Microbiology

- Microbiology is the study of microscopic organisms (generally $<100\mu\text{m}$), such as bacteria, archaea, viruses, fungi, moulds, helminths (worms) and protists (can include prokaryotes and eukaryotes).
- Prokaryotic organisms include bacteria and archaea. On the other hand, eukaryotic organisms include protists (e.g. slime, moulds, protozoans and algae), fungi (e.g. yeast, multicellular moulds and mushrooms), plants (e.g. mosses, ferns, conifers and flowering plants) and animals (e.g. sponges, worms, insects and vertebrates). Viruses are neither prokaryotes or eukaryotes because they are not 'living' cellular organisms (i.e. because they cannot reproduce independently of a host).
- Organisms are referred to in Latin (italicised) using the genus (capitalised) and species (e.g. *Bacillus subtilis*). After mentioning this once in a piece of writing, it can be abbreviated to the first initial of the genus and the species (e.g. *B. subtilis*).
- A classification scheme provides us with a list of characteristics that can be used to help identify an organism. Identification of an organism involves morphology analysis, differential staining, and biochemical tests.
- Microorganisms are involved in a range of different activities which are important for welfare. For example, this includes:
 - (a) Veterinary science (animal health and disease)
 - (b) Agriculture (plant health and disease, nitrogen fixation)
 - (c) Environmental (waste and recycling, biofuels)
 - (d) Food industries (cheese production, beer production, etc.)
 - (e) Human health (disease, protection against disease, natural bodily function)
- Bacteria are present in all habitats. They are a few μm in length and can have many different morphologies. Most bacteria have not yet been characterised as not all can be cultured *in vitro*. Some bacteria can live symbiotically with a host (e.g. are involved in several processes useful for human health) whilst others are very pathogenic.
