Chapter 4: A Hypertext Markup Language Primer

- A browser converts them to what we see on the screen.
- Hypertext Markup Language (HTML) is the main language used to define how a web page should look.
- Hypertext is text that links to other web destinations using a hyperlink.
- We will use the current version of HTML-HTML 5.
- **Tags**
 - Formatting instructions are given by tags, which the browser reads and follows.
 - Tags are words or abbreviations enclosed in angle brackets, < and >.
 - ◆ Tags come in pairs.
 - ◆ The second tag of the pair comes with a slash: <title> Fluency </title>.
 - ◆ The tag pair surrounds the text to be formatted like parenthesis.
- **Working with Tags**
 - Each formatting feature requires its own tag.
 - Programmers and web designers should remember common tags.
 - Uncommon tags can be looked up online.
 - Same tags are required.
- **Required Tags**
 - HTML tags that are required for every web page:
 - <!doctype html>
 - <html>
 - <head> </head>
 - <body> </body>
 - </html>
 - This form must always be followed: <html> <head> <body>
 - The <head> Section:
 - <head>
 - <meta charset = "UTF -8" />
 - <title> Title </title>
 - The head section contains the beginning material like the title and other information that applies to the whole page
 - The <body> Section
 - <body>
 - </body>
 - The body section contains the content of the page.
- HTML source markup tells the browser how to produce the formatted page based on the meaning of the tags.
- Written in a structure format to make it easier for people to understand.
