1

RGB

RGB is a model of using color in which red, green and blue are used exclusively in the creation of new colors.

2

OPACITY

Opacity refers to the level of transparency in a design element.

3

LOGOTYPE/LOGOMARK

A logotype is the company's name designed in a way that is recognizable. A logomark is a mark or symbol that comes to represent the brand.

4

TEXTURE

Texture refers to the characteristics of a design's surface. Various types of textures are used to add dimension or to provide a particular feel.

5

WHITESPACE

The portion of a design that is purposefully left blank.

6

STYLE GUIDE

A style guide is a document that contains the specifications that are to be consistently used when displaying your brand.

7

RASTER

A raster is a type of image that is comprised of pixels. Doesn't scale well.

8

VECTOR

A type of graphic formed using actual lines, points and curves to form shapes. They can be resized without losing their original form.

9

TYPOGRAPHY

Typography is the way in which letters are presented, either digitally or in print.

COLOR PALETTE

The color palette is the combination of colors used in your brand.
