Starting & Stopping

shutdown -h now	Shutdown the system now and do not reboot
halt	Stop all processes - same as above
shutdown -h 5	Shutdown the system in 5 minutes and reboot
shutdown -h now reboot	Shutdown the system now and reboot
shutdown -h now	Stop all processes and then reboot - same as above
startx	Start the X system

Accessing & mounting file systems

mount -t iso9660 /dev/cdrom /mnt/cdrom	Mount the device cdrom and call it cdrom under the /mnt directory
mount -t msdos /dev/fd0 /mnt/fd0	Mount hard disk - d - as a msdos file system and call it fd0 under the /mnt directory
mount -t vfat /dev/fd0 /mnt/fd0	Mount hard disk - d - as a VTFAT file system and call it fd0 under the /mnt directory
umount /mnt/cdrom	Unmount the cdrom

Finding files and text within files

find / -name foobar	Starting with the root directory, look for the file called foobar
find / -name **"foobar**"	Starting with the root directory, look for the file containing the string foobar
locate missingfilename	Find a file called missingfilename using the locate command - this assumes you have already used the command updatedb (see next)
updatedb	Create or update the database of files on all file systems attached to the Linux root directory
which missingfilename	Show the subdirectory containing the executable file - called missingfilename
grep -r matchingfile /dir	Starting with the directory called dir, look for and list all files containing matchingfile

The X Window System

xvidtune	Run the X graphics tuning utility
xf86Setup	Run the X configuration menu with automatic probing of graphics cards
Xconfigurator	Run another X configuration menu with automatic probing of graphics cards
xf86config	Run a text based X configuration menu

Moving, copying, deleting & viewing files

ls -1	List files in current directory using long format
ls -F	List files in current directory and indicate the file type
ls -lvc	List all files in current directory in long format and display in columns

rm name	Remove a file or directory called name
rm -rf name	Kill off an entire directory and all it's included files and sub-directories
cp filename /home/directory	Copy the file called filename to the /home/directory directory
mv filename /home/directory	Move the file called filename to the /home/directory directory
cat filename	Display the file called filename
man -k keyword	Display man pages containing keyword
more filename	Display the file called filename one page at a time, proceed to next page using the spacebar
head filename	Display the first 10 lines of the file called filename
head -20 filename	Display the first 20 lines of the file called filename
tail filename	Display the last 10 lines of the file called filename
tail -20 filename	Display the last 20 lines of the file called filename

Installing software for Linux

rpm -ihe name.rpm	Install the rpm package called name
rpm -Uvh name.rpm	Upgrade the rpm package called name
rpm -e package	Delete the rpm package called package
rpm -q package	List the files in the package called package
rpm -qpl package	List the files and state the installed version of the package called package
rpm -i --force package	Install the rpm package called name having deleted parts of it (not deleting using rpm -e)
tar -xvf archive.tar.gz or tar -xvf archive.tgz	Decompress the files contained in the stripped and tarred archive called archive
./configure	Execute the script preparing the installed files for compiling

adduser accountname	Create a new user called accountname
passwd accountname	Change accountname's new password
su	Log in as superuser from current login
exit	Stop being superuser and revert to normal user
