Functional Movement Screen™ FMSTM The purpose of this study is to investigate the reliability of the FMSTM since only one previous study has investigated the reliability of this screening tool Three subjects were recruited and were videotaped performing the FMSTM test Thirty seven evaluators were divided into one of four groups based on level of experience The evaluators watched each video subject perform each exercise three times The evaluators then came back a week later and watched the video subjects again but in a different order The results demonstrated significant Group by Time differences  $F(3, 33) = 3.67, p = .022$  The main effect for Time also was significant  $F(1, 33) = 4.55, p = .041$  Overall the raters scored the video subjects higher on Day 2  $M = 13.77, SD = .98$  than they did on Day 1  $M = 13.46, SD = .92$  As hypothesized the individuals who were classified as being FMSTM experts had the highest rate of reliability  $ICC = .946$  Therefore reliability of using the FMSTM increases as clinical and FMSTM experience increases These results indicate that the FMSTM has high reliability and can be confidently used by trained individuals
