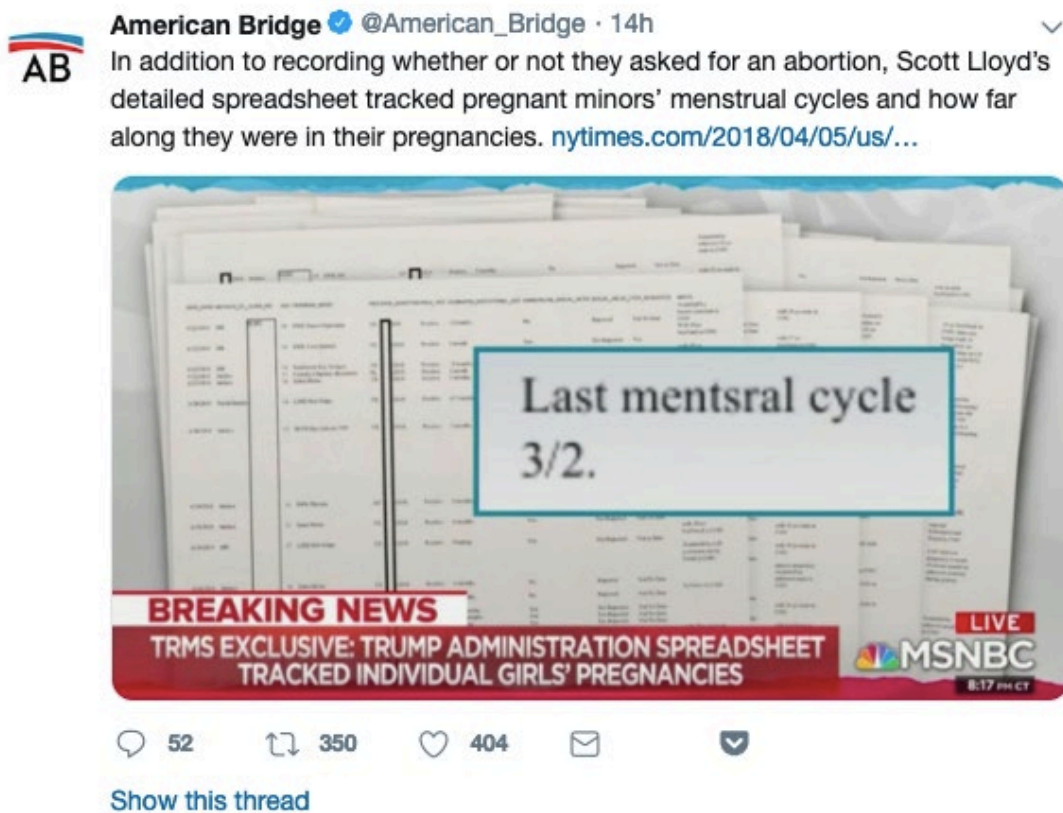
**Last Month Scott Lloyd Told Congress That He Did Not Track Menstrual Cycles Of Women In His Custody**

**Scott Lloyd: “I’m Denying That I Tracked Menstrual Cycles Of Women In My Custody.”**  
DEAN: --And then did not speak up against the policy or speak up about the problems for the children. Something you did take an initiative on, isn't it true that you tracked the menstrual cycles of young girls, young women in your custody? LLOYD: That's not an accurate characterization of what occurred. I am not sure what exactly you're referring to. DEAN: I

believe in a deposition you actually admitted to that. So, you're now saying you did not track the menstrual cycles or you did not have your staff track the menstrual cycles? LLOYD: The best-- DEAN: --It's a yes or no. Did you track--did you create any kind of tracking mechanism-- LLOYD: --Well, I don't have a yes or no answer for the question, but the best guess as to what I--as what you're referring to is is a list that included pregnant women and it would have mentioned their last menstrual period, which is a way of tracking the amount of time that they've been pregnant. DEAN: So, you are now denying that you tracked the menstrual cycles of young women in your custody? You're denying that? LLOYD: I'm denying that I tracked menstrual cycles of women in my custody. I am writing with regard to your

request earlier this week for an estimate of the number of pregnant girls currently in ORR custody nationwide.

(b)(5)

This estimate is based on a cross-check of data pulled from pregnancy-related Treatment Authorization Requests, UAC Medical Module Portal data, Serious Incident Reports, and verification calls to the programs.

As I shared with you earlier this week, this is not 100% foolproof, but the team advises that this is the best available estimate.

Based on the information we have, Medical and Data Teams have determined that **there are (b)(5) sheltering at least one pregnant UC.** Several of these programs do not participate in abortion services due to faith-based objections. In addition to the

Mr. Lloyd,

A 17 yo UAC, admitted on May 2, 2017 to the (b)(6) shelter in TX , was reported during the initial medical examination to be (b) months pregnant and receiving prenatal care while in home country. Child reported pregnancy was a result of consensual sexual relations. The UAC pregnancy screening during the initial medical exam was positive. DHUC team was informed via Intakes notification.

The UAC made no statement or allegation of sexual abuse or assault. There is no medical concern related to this pregnancy identified at this time.

Child will age out of the program on May 9, 2017; the medical personnel referred the UAC to OB/GYN services to resume prenatal care.

The portal does not indicate any request related to information regarding pregnancy termination.

16 yo UAC, admitted on May 22, 2017 to (b)(6) was screen positive for pregnancy during the initial medical exam. Child report pregnancy was a result of (b)(6) UAC reported that she was approximately 24 weeks pregnant. DHUC was informed via standard reporting procedures. The child is being referred to OB/GYN services and was started on prenatal vitamins. The UAC made no statement or allegation of sexual abuse or assault. There is no medical concern related to this pregnancy identified at this time. The portal does not indicate any request related to information regarding pregnancy termination.

UPDATE on Prior Pregnancy Notifications:

16 yo UAC, admitted on May 16, 2017 to (b)(6) reported to be (b)(6) pregnant. Child reported the pregnancy was a result of (b)(6) (b)(6) DHUC was informed via Intake notification on May 16, 2017. DHUC is following up with the program to determine the current clinical plan for the UAC. The portal does not indicate any request related to information regarding pregnancy termination. UPDATE: UAC evaluated by OB Services and determined via US to be (b)(6) weeks pregnant. The child is continuing routine prenatal care. There is no medical concern related to this pregnancy identified at this time.
